Homework and Classwork Activities



- ✓ **Word Train**
 - ✓ Write each word end to end like one long word, using a different color for each word.
- ✓ **Spelling Riddles**
 - ✓ Write riddles for at least 10 spelling words. Don't forget to write the answer to the riddle on the back! A partner will try to solve them!
- ✓ **Scrabble Writing**
 - ✓ Use scrabble letters to find out how many points each of your spelling words are worth.
- ✓ **Sentences**
 - ✓ Put 10 of your words into sentences that will help me understand the words meaning!
- ✓ **Word Art/Spelling Mural**
 - ✓ Draw a picture and hide your words in it! Don't forget to include a key! A partner will try to them!
- ✓ **Good Clean Words**
 - ✓ Spread cream shaving cream out on a surface and trace your words in it three times. Please have someone at home sign off that they saw you do this.
- ✓ **Timer**
 - ✓ Get a timer, set it for 3 minutes. See how many times you can neatly write your words before the timer goes off.
- ✓ **Scramble**
 - ✓ Write your words 3 times. Spell them correctly, then scramble the letters. Then, on the back, unscramble them and write them a third time. A partner will try to solve them!
- ✓ **Letters**
 - ✓ Write your word as many times as there are letters in the word.
- ✓ **Work Out Spell**
 - ✓ Spell your words while you do jumping jacks, push-ups, or crunches. Have someone at home sign off that they saw you do this!
- ✓ **Practice Test**
 - ✓ Have someone give you a practice test. Please write the words that you spelled incorrectly 5 times!
- ✓ **Create an activity**
 - ✓ Can you think of a fun way to do your spelling activities? Try it out!
- ✓ **Crossword Puzzle**
 - ✓ Create a crossword puzzle using at least 10 words.
- ✓ **Concentration**
 - ✓ Make 2 flashcards for each spelling word. Lay them facedown and play concentration (try to find the matches).
- ✓ **Acrostic Poem**
 - ✓ Write an acrostic poem that describes or helps define your word.
- ✓ **Repetition**
 - ✓ Write your words 3 times each, in 3 different colors!
