

**Merrimack High School
PARKING PERMIT AGREEMENT**

Only students who have been issued parking permits will be allowed to park in the **paved student parking lots**.

PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED TO STUDENTS WHO MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- You must have a current year Merrimack High School ID
- You must have a valid New Hampshire Driver's License
- You must present the vehicle registration (of the car you will be driving most often) when applying. The car must be registered to you or an immediate family member.
- You must not owe any fees or fines to Merrimack High School.

**RULES REGARDING STUDENT PARKING
(Please read VERY carefully as rules are strictly enforced.)**

- Place the parking permit on your rearview mirror in the front windshield.
- Do not alter, write on, or otherwise tamper with your permit.
- **Permits are NOT transferable. You may not loan or give a permit to any other student.**
- If, for any reason, you are driving a **different car** than you registered, either move your permit to the other car, or go to the MHS website to fill out a form for the day(s) you will be driving the other car. **This is very important to avoid being ticketed.**
- Obey all the parking rules and drive courteously.
- Permits that are issued are all the same color for the current school year. There is no difference between a "senior" permit and a "junior" permit. Therefore, all students with a valid permit may park in *any* lot marked Student Parking.
- Park **ONLY** in lined spaces in the **Student Parking Lots**. (See parking map.)
 - DO NOT park in spaces or lots marked reserved, staff/faculty, or visitors.
 - DO NOT park in the spaces designated for the Student Services Building (the gray building near staff parking) or the SAU Offices (the green building).
 - DO NOT park cars on the motorcycle/bicycle pad.
 - **DO NOT park in grass or dirt, along the road, any place designated "No Parking", or in the Fire Lane.**
- A violation of ANY of these rules may result in an MHS Parking Ticket, ranging from \$20-\$50 dollars, booting, and/or towing at the student's risk and expense. Repeated violations may result in loss of the permit, and for juniors, may also affect the ability to apply for a permit in the future.
- Violations of other school rules may also result in loss of a parking permit.
- The administration has the right to search vehicles on school property per MHS policy.
- If your permit is missing, please notify the main office immediately.

By applying for a parking permit, you agree that Merrimack High School and the Merrimack School District provides parking as a courtesy only, and may not be held responsible for any theft, vandalism, damage, or liability that may occur.
