



Build Your List

Build your list intentionally

For each school you add, do you have at least 2-3 specific reasons why it made the list?

Balanced approach

Higher probability and lower probability schools


In-state, out-of-state, public, private

Consider the type of financial aid offered

Do they offer meritbased aid?

Do they offer ONLY need-based aid?

Do they offer **BOTH** need-based **AND** merit-based aid?



Applying to College

Admission Options

Admission Type	Details	Deadline	Commitment
Early Decision	 Cannot apply to more than one school ED If admitted, student agrees to enroll and withdraw all other applications Student, parent, and school counselor sign contract 	October – November Some schools will offer EDI and EDII	Binding
Early Action (EA)	Applications reviewed and decisions sent early	November – December Some schools will offer EAI and EAII	Non-binding
Regular Decision	All applications reviewed after hard deadline	January – March	Non-binding
Rolling Admission	 First come, first served Applications reviewed as received Class may be filled early in cycle, so apply accordingly 	Within a specific time- frame until class is filled	Non-binding
Direct Admission	 Student offered acceptance before applying based on certain criteria, such as self-reported GPA or demographics In general, must complete application and meet all eligibility criteria Common App, Niche, school-specific 	Throughout admission cycle	Non-binding


Application Options

Common Application

- Opens August 1st
- Accepted by over 1,000 schools
- Fee waivers available

College-Specific Application

- Found on college website
- May waive application fee

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Essential Elements of the Application

What are your colleges requiring from you?

High School Transcript

College Essay Extra-Curricular Activities

Letters of Rec

SAT/ACT Scores

Standardized Testing

Test-Optional Admissions

- You decide whether you want to submit test scores
- Scores may be required for merit scholarship consideration

Test-Blind Admissions

Test scores are never considered


Additional Elements to Consider

- Which majors require these?
- When should you plan to audition?
- Is this part of the application process?
- How are portfolios submitted?
- Check individual schools for portfolio workshop options
- Are you planning on playing a Division I or Division Il sport?
- Register with the Eligibility Center <u>ncaa.org</u>
