



Band Supplies List (as stated in the Band Handbook)

Please have the following items by Friday, Sept. 21st!

All Band Students:

- Music Book:
 - 7th Grade: Standard of Excellence – **Book 2** (Pearson; Kjos (Pub.))
 - 8th Grade: Standard of Excellence – **Book 3** (Pearson; Kjos (Pub.))
(You must **also** have your Standard of Excellence – **Book 2** – from last year!)
- Instrument in proper working condition
- ¼” - ½” Wide Binder - BLACK
- 15-20 Plastic Sheet Protectors (share a package with a friend!)
- Instrument case/sticks clearly labeled with name and phone number
- Flip folder
- Lyre (with appropriate attachments for instrument) (Music and Arts can help!)
 - Percussion, Bassoon – do not need this!
 - Flutes, French Horns, Euphonium, Oboe – get the flute arm flip folder/lyre combination!

Instrument specific items:

- Clarinets/Saxophones – a supply of good reeds to last you for several months (a box of 10 should easily get you through the year if you take care of them) (you must have AT LEAST 3 good reeds in your case at all times), cleaning swab, cork grease, mouthpiece cover
- Flutes – cleaning rod, small clean cloth
- Bassoons/Oboes – at least 2 good reeds, a reed case, cork grease, small cup for soaking your reed
- Trumpets, Euphoniums, Tubas - valve oil, slide grease for tuning slides
- Trombones - slide cream with a small water spray bottle (like a travel-sized hairspray bottle) OR trombone slide oil; slide grease for tuning slides
- French Horns – rotary valve oil, slide grease for tuning slides
- Percussion – 1 pair “Vic Firth SD1 General” Drumsticks (or other “5B” drumstick) (no extra skinny or extra fat sticks!)
