D The heavy leather sandals had iron nails on the soles, similar to cleats today.

E The metal plate of armor tied together with leather straps protected the upper body.

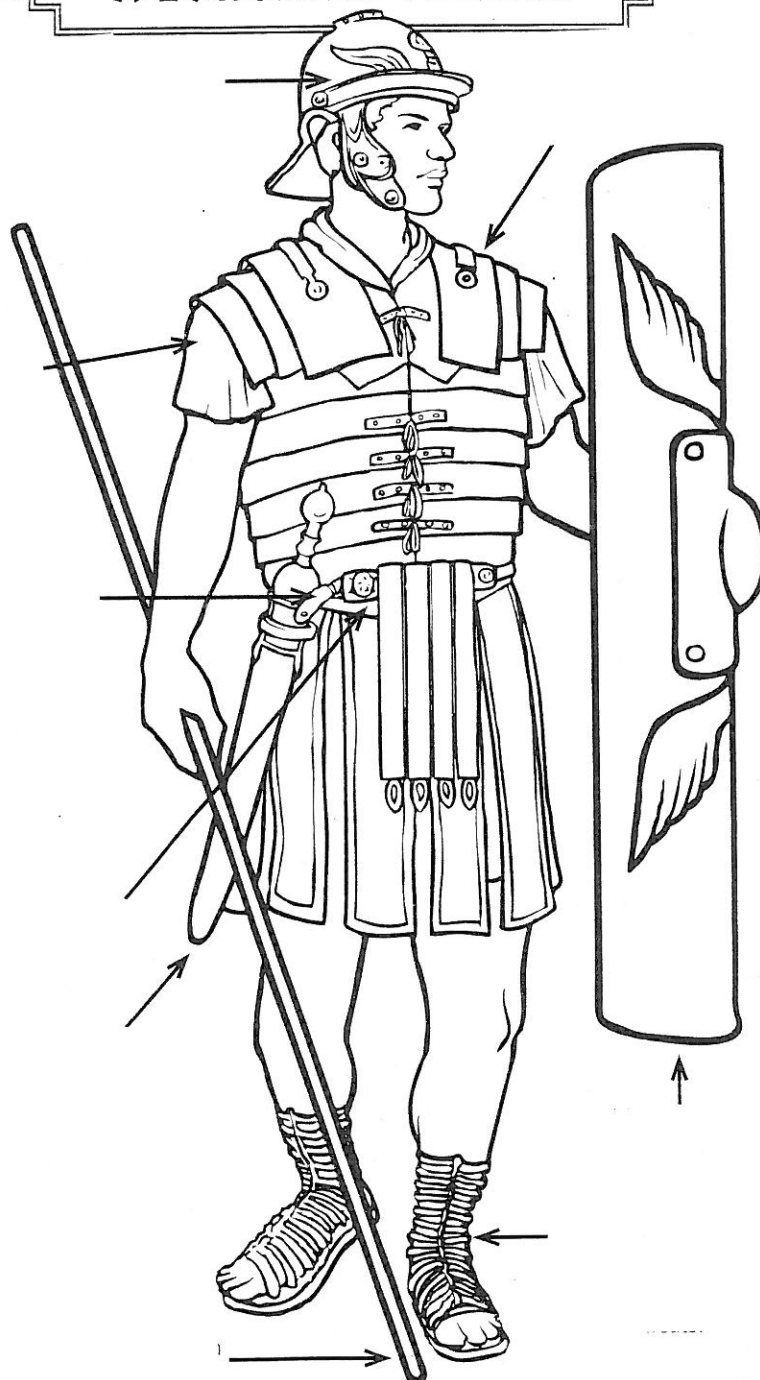
F A metal helmet had a projecting piece in the back and front and cheek pieces on the sides.

G A dagger was strapped to the soldier's belt.

H A double-edged sword hung from a strap on the right side of the body.

I The soldier carried a javelin that had a long metal tip.
